<b>NOM.</b>	= Subject	<b>terra</b>	= <i>the land</i>
<b>GEN.</b>	= Poss./Descr.	<b>terrae</b>	= <i>the land's, of the land</i>
<b>DAT.</b>	= Pers. Int./Indir. Obj.	<b>terrae</b>	= <i>to or for the land</i>
<b>ACC.</b>	= Direct Object	<b>terram</b>	= <i>the land</i>
<b>ABL.</b>	= Obj. of var. preps.	<b>terrā</b>	= <i>in, at, with, by, from the land</i>

<b>DAT.</b>	= Pers. Int./Indir. Obj.	<b>terrīs</b>	= <i>to or for the lands</i>
<b>ACC.</b>	= Direct Object	<b>terras</b>	= <i>the lands</i>
<b>ABL.</b>	= Obj. of var. preps.	<b>terrīs</b>	= <i>in, at, with, by, from the lands</i>
